AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this 16th day of April 1928, by and between STADIUM CONCERTS, INC., hereinafter called the party of the first part, of New York, and J. Emmitte as a member of Local 802 of the American Federation of Musicians, hereinafter called the party of the second part.

FIRST: That the party of the second part shall agree to play *Bells* in the orchestra of STADIUM CONCERTS, INC. at the Lewisohn Stadium, or elsewhere, in rehearsals and concerts whenever called upon, for eight weeks commencing on or about July 5th 1928, the party of the first part to have the privilege of calling orchestra for rehearsals on or about July 5th at the rate of \$5. per rehearsal.

SECOND: That the party of the first part agrees to pay to the party of the second part for services described in the foregoing paragraph the sum of \$95. weekly for seven concerts in each and every one of the eight weeks aforementioned, and four rehearsals of not more than two and a half hours each. Extra rehearsals of two and a half each to be paid at the rate of \$5. per man.

THIRD: That the party of the first part shall have the privilege of extending the term of this agreement from week to week without further notice than an announcement to the party of the second part of such extension in the last week of the eight weeks aforementioned.

THIS AGREEMENT made this 7, day of March 1930 by and between STADIUM CONCERTS, INC., hereinafter called the party of the first part, of New York, and J. E. Emonts as a member of Local 802 of the American Federation of Musicians, hereinafter called the party of the second part.

FIRST: That the party of the second part shall agree to play and Solo Cells in the orchestra of STADIUM CONCERTS, INC., at the Lewisohn Stadium, or elsewhere, in rehearsals and concerts whenever called upon, for eight weeks commencing on or about July 7, 1930, the party of the first part to have the privilege of calling orchestra for rehearsals on or about July 7, at the rate of \$5. per rehearsal.

SECOND: That the party of the first part agrees to pay to the party of the second part for services described in the foregoing paragraph the sum of \$420 weekly for seven concerts in each and every one of the eight weeks aforementioned, and four rehearsals of not more than two and a half hours each. Extra rehearsals of two and a half hours each to be paid at the rate of \$5. per man.

THIRD: That the party of the first part shall have the privilege of extending the term of this agreement from week to week without further notice than an announcement to the party of the second part of such extension in the last week of the eight weeks aforementioned.
